

## **BLACKWOOD FIRE COMPANY OPERATING GUIDELINE**

### **7.9 FIREFIGHTER SAFETY - EMERGENCY EVACUATION SIGNAL**

- 7.9.1 The IC shall notify Camden County to broadcast the Emergency Evacuation Signal any time a direct hazard to any personnel operating in, on, or around a structure or other hazardous area exists.
- 7.9.2 Upon receipt of the Emergency Evacuation Signal, apparatus operators shall sound air horns continuously for 30 seconds. Division, group, and company officers shall pass the order to all personnel operating in the affected area and direct personnel to the Command Post.
- 7.9.3 Upon broadcast of the Emergency Evacuation signal, the IC shall implement accountability IAW OG# 7.8.
- 7.9.4 The Emergency Evacuation Signal shall not be utilized to signal a routine change in operations, where personnel will be removed from an area and no direct or immediate hazard exists.
