- Lime green with orange and silver reflective striping
- Provided for all riding positions




#### Policy

- Effective 11/24/2008, Federal Highway Administration Regulation 23 CFR part 634 mandates use of high visibility safety apparel when working on Federal Aid Highways.
  - Includes State Highway 42
- Blackwood Fire Company policy mandates use of vests whenever personnel are operating in an area where they are exposed to passing traffic.

#### Vest Storage Locations

Storage cabinet above SCBA seats



- Remove vest from the storage location
- Unfold the vest and hold it so the 84 is facing you



- Grasp the midpoint of the bottom panel and hold it in front of your body
  - 84 upside down at top
  - Reflective side facing away from you



- Put the vest over your head and shoulders
  - Can be accomplished with or without helmet on







- Attach side straps
- Adjust vest as necessary to ensure proper coverage in front, rear and sides








#### Restoring Vest

- Proper restoration of the vest will ensure it is ready to be rapidly and properly donned by the next member to use it
  - Improper restoration greatly increases the time and difficulty in donning the vest

- After removing the vest, ensure the zipper is closed and the shoulder strap tabs are properly fastened
- Side straps should be unfastened and folded over on themselves so there is NO exposed velcro
  - Exposed velco will stick to other portions of vest, making it difficult to unfold



### Restoring Vest

- Fold vest in half from side to side (1)
- Then fold in half twice from top to bottom (2 and 3)
- Return vest to appropriate storage location
